

## VISTA Scavenger Hunt<sup>1</sup>

This scavenger hunt will introduce you to our program and community. For off-site locations, it will be up to you to discover locations and how to get there. Take a camera and take pictures, if the task does not require you to collect something. You have two months to complete the hunt.

- 1) Find City Hall.
- 2) Find the Meet the VISTAs bulletin board and tack up your picture.
- 3) Attend the Connections Café Lunch at the Community Partnership Center. Bring back three flyers that could assist you in your project.
- 4) Find the Neighborhood Center. Learn about three programs that are offered there.
- 5) Introduce yourself to the High School Principal
- 6) Attend the meeting of the Kiwanis chapter. Introduce yourself to the director.
- 7) Find the Grocery Outlet.
- 8) Find out which board member is a former rodeo clown.
- 9) Visit the Family Resource Center at the elementary school and learn why VISTAs go there at least once per week.
- 10) Locate at least three teen centers in town. Visit them, pick up brochures/information, and introduce yourself to the site coordinators.
- 11) Go to lunch with the other VISTAS.
- 12) Write a short bio for yourself and post to the agency intranet.
- 13) Read the most recent copy of the town independent newspaper. Attend a local event that is mentioned in the paper.
- 14) Find the Social Security office and pick up a copy of their publication, “A Guide To Supplemental Security Income (SSI) For Groups And Organizations”.
- 15) Find a copy of our agency’s Annual Report, go the Audited Financial section, and calculate what percent of our revenue comes from federal grants and contracts.
- 16) Access the foundation database (a Development staffer can help you) and find three corporate foundations that fund mentoring projects.
