The AmeriCorps Member will serve August 22, 2016 through August 21, 2017. VISTA Pre-Service Orientation begins in August and is mandatory.

Benefits

VISTA Members are eligible for an \$11,676 stipend, health coverage, child care benefits and a \$5,775 education award. Members are provided with mileage reimbursement and professional development trainings.
